Our U.S. House Representative Buddy Carter led off, and reminded us that 70% of Americans think our country is going in the wrong, and that this year's midterm elections can right the ship, if Republicans take control of Congress. At the end of the Trump term, inflation was 1.4%, and is now 8.2%. Biden immediately declared war on energy, opened the Southern Border to drug cartels causing massive illegal immigration, Fentanyl fatalities averaging 200 lives a day, and who knows how many getaways of international terrorists. With a Senate return to the GOP, and a reelection of Governor Kemp, plus other state victories, all that is left for a return to prosperity is a Republican White House in 2024.
